

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



Links and tips for creating codes (explanation here, links below):

1. Binary codes: just short words :) it is easy to translate if you use the web.
2. Cryptograms: (freight train example from my room). You can choose to give away some of the letters in the cryptogram to give the solver a head start. Try not to make it too difficult or too easy.
3. use locks like: "Find the synonym ofwhich is rhyming to....."
4. Anna suggested mirror coding - find the link below.
5. Reverse writing: meet me outside - becomes coded: teem em edistuo
6. Reflect method (screenshot below)
7. David suggested: Morse code translator
8. Employ the code used by Mary, Queen of Scots. While trying to send messages during a time of political turmoil, Mary, Queen of Scots, used symbols as a substitute code for
